11 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell
12 Chapter 2 Administration, Sec. 2-46 Temporary absence, Sec. 2-48 Appointment of
13 assistant during absence to be at mayor's discretion, and Sec. 2-52 Appointment of
14 assistant during period of disability, in mayor's discretion.

17 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter 2 Administration,
18 Article IV, Mayor absence or disability, Sec. 2-46 Temporary absence is hereby amended
19 as follows: delete "seventy-two (72) hours" and replace with "five (5) consecutive working
20 days".

21 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Sec. 2-48 Appointment of assistant during
22 absence to be at mayor's discretion is hereby amended as follows: In the first sentence
23 delete "appoint his executive assistant" and replace with "appoint an appointive
24 administrative officer subject to the Mayor's direction and supervision".

25 BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that Sec. 2-52 Appointment of assistant during
26 periods of disability, in mayor's discretion is hereby amended by deleting "appoint the
27 executive assistant to mayor" and replace with "appoint an appointive administrative
28 officer subject to the Mayor's direction and supervision", and delete "three (3) days" and
29 replace with "five (5) consecutive working days".
