7 **ORDINANCE NO. 2616**

9 An ordinance establishing and setting salaries for elected officials for the  
10 City of Slidell.

11 WHEREAS, Section 3-06 of the Home Rule Charter provides for the Mayor  
12 of the City of Slidell to have a salary increase by not more than the average percentage  
13 of increase granted annually to all City employees; and

14 WHEREAS, all City employees will receive a 4.55% average percentage  
15 increase during fiscal year 1996; and

16 WHEREAS, the salary for the Slidell Chief of Police has been set at 90%  
17 of the salary of the Mayor; and

18 WHEREAS, Section 2-04 of the Home Rule Charter provides for salary  
19 adjustments for Council Members to be adopted at least one year prior to the beginning  
20 of the term of office, and said salary adjustment can not become effective during the term  
21 of office in which it was enacted.

22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that  
23 effective July 1, 1995, the salary of the Mayor shall be set at \$61,021 and the salary for  
24 the Chief of Police shall be \$54,918.

25 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the salary for the Council Members shall  
26 be \$12,800 per year beginning with the term of office effective July 1, 1998.
