12 An ordinance authorizing the exchange of certain City equipment for repairs  
13 made to an emergency diesel drive engine to serve as a back-up for the Bayou Vincent  
14 Pumping Station at the Slidell City barn.

16 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell solicited quotes to rebuild a certain diesel  
17 engine at the Bayou Vincent Pumping Station; and

18 WHEREAS, the low quote was submitted by Pro Diesel Service in  
19 Covington, Louisiana; and

20 WHEREAS, the cost to repair the emergency diesel drive engine is  
21 approximately six thousand nine hundred and eighty six dollars (\$6,986.00); and

22 WHEREAS, Pro Diesel Service has requested that we exchange certain  
23 City equipment for the repair work to said emergency diesel drive engine; and


24 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell Fleet Manager has determined through  
25 prior auctions that the value of the requested exchange equipment is consistent with  
26 the cost of repairing said diesel engine.

27 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it  
28 does hereby authorize an exchange of the following City equipment:

- 29 1. A 1981 International dump truck vehicle unit number 87 with an  
30 approximate value of one thousand seven hundred dollars (\$1,700.00).  
31 2. A 1980 Case backhoe - unit number 86 - with an approximate value of  
32 four thousand six hundred dollars (\$4,600.00).  
33 3. A 1980 Food fifth wheel truck - unit number 420 - with an approximate  
34 value of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).

35 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the herein described City equipment  
36 shall be exchanged with Pro Diesel Service in Covington, Louisiana, for the value of  
37 rebuilding one emergency diesel drive engine having an equivalent value of the herein  
38 stated City equipment.




