ORDINANCE NO. 2664

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Slidell to acquire real property located on U.S. Highway 11 near Slidell, Louisiana, for storm water runoff detention ponds.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a \$9.5 million Capital Improvement Drainage Program under way; and

WHEREAS, part of the improvement requires the acquisition of land along U. S. Highway 11 to be used as a detention pond.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby authorize its Mayor to execute all documents necessary to acquire 13.66 acres of vacant land located on U. S. Highway 11 near Slidell, Louisiana, more fully described as a certain parcel of ground situated in Section 34, Township 8 South, range 14 East and Section 3, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, all in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement to Purchase attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Slidell City Attorney shall prepare all documents necessary for the purchase of said property.
