ORDINANCE NO. 2685

An ordinance revoking the twenty (20) foot right-of-way on the north and south sides of an undeveloped road known as Roosevelt Street.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has received a right-of-way revocation request from Madge E. Gotz for a portion of an undeveloped road between 5th and 11th Streets, approximately one block south of and parallel to Fremaux Avenue; and


WHEREAS, this part of the right-of-way is not needed for public use; and
WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission has issued a favorable recommendation for said revocation.


