**ORDINANCE NO. 2686**

An ordinance establishing and setting salaries for elected officials for the  
City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, Section 3-06 of the Home Rule Charter provides for the Mayor  
of the City of Slidell to have a salary increase by not more than the average percentage  
of increase granted annually to all City employees; and

WHEREAS, all City employees will receive a 4.18% average percentage  
increase during fiscal year 1996; and

WHEREAS, the salary for the Slidell Chief of Police has been set at 90%  
of the salary of the Mayor.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that  
effective July 1, 1996, the salary of the Mayor shall be set at \$63,569 and the salary for  
the Chief of Police shall be \$57,212.
