8 **ORDINANCE NO. 2709**

10 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
11 Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control, to provide for the hours of operation for all
12 businesses licensed to sell or dispense alcoholic beverages at retail by-the-drink.
13

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter 3 Alcoholic
15 Beverage Control, Section 3-13 Sunday sales, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
16 Slidell is hereby amended as follows:
17

18 Chapter 3 - Alcoholic Beverage Control, in the title Section 3-13 delete "Sunday
19 sales" and replace with the following:

20 "Additional requirements and regulations for retail dispensing of alcoholic
21 beverages."

22 Chapter 3 - Alcoholic Beverage Control, Section 3-13 Sunday sales, delete the
23 second paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following:

24 "All businesses, persons, or firms who are licensed to sell or dispense
25 alcoholic beverages at retail by-the-drink shall close their doors to entry at
26 2:00 a.m. daily and remain closed until 9:00 a.m. daily. No bar, barrooms,
27 lounges, nightclubs, saloons, restaurants, or other types of businesses
28 licensed for the retail sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the
29 premises shall remain in operation or allow any persons other than the
30 employees of the permittee to remain on its premises between the hours of
31 2:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. daily. This section shall not apply on the following
32 days: January 1, the Saturday and Monday morning preceding Mardi Gras
33 Day and Mardi Gras Day itself."


34 "Section 3-17 Penalties" is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph
35 thereto:

36 "Whoever violates any provisions of subsection 3-13 of this Chapter shall
37 be fined two hundred dollars (\$200.00) on the first offense, five hundred
38 dollars (\$500.00) on the second offense, and five hundred dollars (\$500.00)


6 plus suffer the revocation of its permit to sell alcoholic beverages of any
