9 **ORDINANCE NO. 2716**
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12 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the
13 new millage rates required by reassessment conducted by the St. Tammany Parish Tax
14 Assessor in 1996 and as further required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the
15 Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police
16 Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government, as
17 well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general
18 obligation bonds, in said City for the year 1997.

20 WHEREAS, the Louisiana State Constitution requires the Tax Assessor to
21 reassess all property every four (4) years, and adjust rates accordingly.

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of
23 Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate tax
24 of thirty-seven and twenty-nine one hundredths (37.29) mills on the dollar upon all
25 property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according
26 to the assessment roll of said City in the calendar year 1996.

27 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is
28 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys: a tax of 5.66 mills for the
29 purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues to pay and defray the expenses of
30 the municipal government and for the general municipal and local purposes in the City
31 of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1997, as shown by the budget for the year 1997,
32 adopted by the City Council of said City. So authorized by Louisiana Constitution Article
33 VI, Section 27 at 5.66 mills.

34 A tax of 2.32 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal
35 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1997. So authorized by
36 the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1984.

37 A tax of 2.78 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal
38 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1997. So authorized by
39 the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.
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6 A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in the City
7 of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1997. So authorized by the special taxpayer election
8 held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.

9 A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of the
10 City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1997. So authorized by the special taxpayer
11 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.

12 A tax of 2.32 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving public
13 works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1997. So authorized by the special
14 taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.

15 A tax of 1.42 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest
16 and maturing bonds for the 1977 Drainage Improvement Bonds Series B of the City of
17 Slidell, Louisiana for the year 1997, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election
18 held April 13, 1976, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Councilmen of the City of
19 Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 13th day of April 1976, and the 16th day of November,
20 1976.

22 A tax of 2.18 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest
23 and maturing bonds for the 1977 Sewerage Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell,
24 Louisiana, for the year 1997, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election held April
25 13, 1976, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Councilmen of the City of Slidell,
26 Louisiana, passed on the 13th day of April 1976, and the 16th day of November, 1976.

27 A tax of 2.71 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest
28 and maturing bonds for the 1989 Water Bonds Series A, and 1989 Sewer Bonds Series
29 B, and the 1989 Refunding Bonds Series C of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year
30 1997, as authorized by a special taxpayers election held November 8, 1988, and by a
31 Resolution of the Mayor and the Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on
32 the 24th day of January 1989.

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
5 A tax of 2.83 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
6 interest and maturing bonds for the 1994 General Obligation Refunding Bonds of the City
7 of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1997, as authorized by a special election held November
8 8, 1988, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of Slidell,
9 Louisiana, passed on the 8th day of March, 1994.


10 A tax of 5.07 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
11 interest and maturing bonds for the 1996 General Obligation Bonds for the City of Slidell,
12 Louisiana, for the year 1997, as authorized by a special election held November 18, 1995,
13 and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of Slidell,
14 Louisiana, passed on the 12th day of September, 1995.


