11 An ordinance prohibiting the use of internal combustion engines upon a
12 certain tract of land in the Palm Lake Bayou Bonfouca area designated as a Wildlife
13 Refuge, Bird Sanctuary, and Nature Park owned by the City of Slidell.
14

15 WHEREAS, on August 14, 1984 and May 14, 1995, the City of Slidell
16 accepted donations of land from M. P. Schneider III et al; and

17 WHEREAS, said property was officially designated as a Palm Lake area
18 Wildlife Refuge, Bird Sanctuary and Nature Park by City of Slidell by Ordinance No. 2502
19 dated May 25, 1993; and


20 WHEREAS, there should be no undue or unnecessary disruptions to the
21 wildlife and plants in their natural surroundings in said refuge and sanctuary.

22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it
23 does hereby prohibit the use of any internal combustion engines including, but not limited
24 to, inboard motors, outboard motors, gasoline, diesel, or natural gas powered or propelled
25 motors in and on said refuge and sanctuary except for the use of battery powered electric
26 motors shall be permitted.


