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9 **ORDINANCE NO. 2800**

10 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7 Buildings, and
11 Chapter 15 Streets, Sidewalks, Etc., to provide for revisions in rainwater runoff control.

12 WHEREAS, the City Engineering Department is recommending changes to
13 our regulations regarding rainwater runoff by requiring certain retention and detention
14 control methods.

15 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
16 hereby amend Chapter 7 Buildings, Section 7-35 Standards for subdivision proposals,
17 Paragraph (d) (3) as follows:

18 Delete all language and replace with:

19 "Post-construction runoff shall at a maximum be equal to 90% of the pre-
20 construction runoff. The developer shall determine the means necessary to reduce post-
21 construction runoff to accommodate this regulation. The reduction in runoff shall be
22 achieved through retention/detention methods unless otherwise approved by the City
23 Administration, which would normally consist of the Mayor or his designee, the City
24 Planner, the Permit Director, and the City Engineer. Prior to any approval of less than
25 90% pre-construction runoff, the City Administration shall give written notification to the
26 Slidell City Council Office and justification therefor. Requests for lower percentage
27 reduction must be approved in writing by the City Administration, which would normally
28 consist of the Mayor or his designee, the City Planner, the Permit Director, and the City
29 Engineer."

30 Chapter 15 Streets, Sidewalks, Etc., is amended as follows:


31 Section 15-69 Design, delete all language and replace with:

32 "Storm drainage designs shall incorporate retention/detention measures to control
33 storm water runoff. Post-construction runoff shall at a maximum not exceed 90% of pre-
34 construction runoff. Design shall evaluate and recommend the means to accomplish this

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6 reduction in runoff. All design data and calculations shall be submitted to the City
7 Engineer for review and approval prior to a building permit being issued. Approval by the
8 City Engineer shall be issued in writing before the building permit is released. Compliance
9 with the maximum 90% of pre-construction runoff rule shall be achieved unless otherwise
10 approved in writing by the City Administration, which would normally consist of the Mayor
11 or his designee, the City Planner, the Permit Director and the City Engineer. Prior to any
12 approval of less than 90% pre-construction runoff, the City Administration shall give written
13 notification to the Slidell City Council Office and justification therefor. Requests for lower
14 percentage reduction must be approved in writing by the City Administration, which would
15 normally consist of the Mayor or his designee, the City Planner, the Permit Director, and
16 the City Engineer.”

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
