8 **ORDINANCE NO. 2829**

10 An ordinance annexing a portion of the I-10 East Service Road (also known  
11 as Howze Beach Road).  
12

13 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has received a petition from the  
14 Administration to annex the current right-of-way of the I-10 East Service Road from the  
15 current City limit line at the intersection of LA Hwy. 433 and the I-10 East Service Road  
16 south to its intersection with Oak Harbor Blvd. (Eden Isles) interchange centerline,  
17 between the eastern roadway pavement edge to the eastern right-of-way line; and  
18

19 WHEREAS, the I-10 East Service Road (also known as Howze Beach Road)  
20 connects the current City limits to 7.30 acres of land petitioned to the City for annexation  
21 by the property owners; and

22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the  
23 following described parcel of land be annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Slidell  
24 into Councilmanic District B.

25 From the existing City limits, at the intersection of Old Spanish Trail  
26 and the I-10 Service Road a distance of 3.1 miles ( $\pm$ .5 miles) to the  
27 intersection of the interchange roadway crossing I-10, the I-10  
28 Service Road right-of-way between the eastern edge of the roadway  
29 surface to the eastern Service Road right-of-way, as shown on the  
30 current maps delineating the State road system.


