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8 **ORDINANCE NO. 2834**

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10 An ordinance amending Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control of the Code
11 of Ordinances of the City of Slidell to provide certain qualifications for the holding of
12 alcoholic beverage licenses and the dispensing thereof.

14 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has certain provisions regarding the control
15 of alcoholic beverage licensing and dispensing thereof; and

16 WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office conducts certain classes
17 which are prerequisites for certain types of dispensation; and

18 WHEREAS, the Slidell Police Department enforces provisions of the
19 alcoholic beverage control ordinance.

20 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
21 hereby amend its Code of Ordinances, Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control, Section 3-
22 20 Certificates of qualification, by adding the qualifications as follows:

23 Chapter 3 Alcoholic Beverage Control, Section 3-20 Certifications of qualification
24 add the following:

25 "(3.1) *Qualifications of applicant for certificate.* Each applicant for a
26 certificate of qualification to dispense alcoholic beverages, whether
27 original or renewal shall possess the following qualifications:

- 28 (a) Is a person of good character and reputation and over eighteen
29 (18) years of age and duly qualified under the provisions of this
30 section.
- 31 (b) Has not been convicted of a felony under the laws of the United
32 States, the State of Louisiana, or any other state or country.
- 33 (c) Has not been convicted in this or any other state or by the
34 United States or any other country of soliciting for prostitution,
35 pandering, letting premises for prostitution, contributing to the
36 delinquency of juveniles, keeping a disorderly place or illegally
37 dealing in narcotics as defined in R.S. 40 of this state.

6 (d) Has not had a license or permit to sell or deal in alcoholic
7 beverages by the United States, or any other state thereof, or
8 by a political subdivision of any state authorized to issue
9 permits for licenses, revoked within one year prior to
10 application, or had a judgment of a court of competent
11 jurisdiction rendered against him involving alcoholic beverages
12 by this or any other state or by the United States for one year
13 prior to this application.


14 (e) Has not been adjudged by the board of alcoholic beverage
15 control or convicted by any court of violation of the provisions
16 of Title 26 or Title 28 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes dealing
17 with alcoholic beverages.

18 (f) Has not been convicted of violating any municipal or parish
19 ordinances adopted pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 26:493.

20 (g) Has not had a certificate of qualification to dispense alcoholic
21 beverages issued by any other parish, municipality or state
22 suspended or revoked.

23 (h) Original applicants must have completed the St. Tammany
24 Sheriff's Department course entitled "Responsible Alcohol
25 Service." Renewal applicants must have completed the
26 "Responsible Alcohol Service Refresher Course."

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
