8 **ORDINANCE NO. 2849**

10 An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Slidell to enter into a joint
11 agreement with the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff for property tax collection purposes.
12

13 WHEREAS, the Sheriff for St. Tammany Parish and the City of Slidell desire
14 to enter to a joint agreement for the collection of property taxes; and

15 WHEREAS, the merchants, citizens and taxpayers would be best served by
16 a single tax collector; and

17 WHEREAS, the Sheriff for St. Tammany Parish has all the applicable
18 ordinances, regulations and state statutes to serve as the property tax collector for the City
19 of Slidell; and

20 WHEREAS, the Sheriff would be paid \$3.20 for each bill; and

21 WHEREAS, the agreement would be for four (4) years beginning July 1,
22 1998, and would automatically renew on four (4) year intervals unless terminated in writing
23 by either party.

24 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it
25 hereby authorizes the Mayor of the City of Slidell to enter into a joint agreement with the
26 St. Tammany Sheriff for purposes of collecting the City of Slidell 's property taxes all in
27 accordance with the Joint Agreement for Collection of Property Tax attached hereto and
28 made a part hereof.


