8 **ORDINANCE NO. 2861**

10 An ordinance amending Chapter 20 - Water of the Code of Ordinances of the
11 City of Slidell to provide for payment of costs involved in disconnecting unauthorized water
12 users.
13

14 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has an ordinance that provides for a criminal
15 fine and/or incarceration for people connecting to the City's water system without
16 permission and without a water meter; and
17

18 WHEREAS, the ordinance does not provide for payment for the water used
19 nor for the labor and materials used in disconnecting the unauthorized connection; and
20

21 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell desires to recoup the costs involved in
22 disconnecting these unauthorized users.

23 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
24 hereby amend Chapter 20 - Water, Section 20-9 Tampering With System as follows:

25 Section 20-9 (d) Add the following sentence after the word "both."

26 "Additionally, any person who makes any connection to the City waterworks
27 system without permission shall be assessed a charge for the water used plus the cost of
28 labor and materials necessary to disconnect the unauthorized connection."




