9 An ordinance revoking that portion of Main Street (not constructed), Pearl
10 Acres subdivision, from Gause Boulevard to its intersection with City Avenue (not
11 constructed).

13 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has received a request from Mr. Larry
14 Breland to revoke 294.16 feet of Main Street, Pearl Acres Subdivision; and

15 WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission has issued a
16 favorable recommendation for said revocation.

17 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
18 hereby revoke 294.16 feet of Main Street, 60' right-of-way, (not constructed), Pearl Acres
19 Subdivision, from Gause Boulevard to its intersection with City Avenue (not constructed),
20 and with the following boundary description of a portion of Main Street right-of-way:

21 All that certain parcel of land in Pearl Acres Subdivision, St. Tammany
22 Parish, Louisiana, more fully described as follows:

23
24 From the Southeast corner of Square 23 of said subdivision, being the
25 POINT OF BEGINNING, go Northerly 294.16 feet to a point; thence go
26 Easterly 60.00 feet to the Northwest corner of Square 22 of said subdivision;
27 thence go Southerly 273.81 feet to a point on the northerly right-of-way line
28 of Gause Boulevard; thence go along said right-of-way line Southwesterly
29 63.3 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Containing in all 0.39 acres of land,
30 more or less.




