7 **ORDINANCE NO. 2872**

10 An ordinance amending the Criminal Code Chapter 9 of the Code of  
11 Ordinances of the City of Slidell to prohibit the use of silly string and other similar  
12 substances within 150 feet of a parade route.  
13

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter 9 Criminal Code of  
15 the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell Section 9-81, Regulating Parades, is hereby  
16 amended as follows:

17 \*Add Paragraph (K) *Illegal Objects & Substances.*

18 (1) It shall be unlawful for any spectator or participant to throw, spray or propel,  
19 or cause to be thrown, sprayed or propelled, any object or substance at or  
20 toward any spectator or participant of a parade while such parade is forming,  
21 being held or disbanding;

22 (2) It shall be unlawful for any street vendor to sell any object or substance during  
23 the period for which a temporary vendor's permit is issued pursuant to the Code  
24 of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 12, Peddlers and Solicitors, Section  
25 12½-6. Other exempted persons.

26 (3) For purposes of this subsection, the following definitions shall apply:

27 (a) *Participant* means any person, animal, vehicle or float which forms any  
28 part of a parade.

29 (b) *Spectator* means any person other than a participant.

30 (c) *Any object or substance* means silly string or its equivalent, cracker  
31 balls, firecrackers, or any pyrotechnic or explosive device.

32 (d) *Parade* means any parade, march, ceremony, show, exhibition, pageant,  
33 or procession of any kind, or any similar display, in or upon any street,  
34 park or other public place in this municipality."




