8 **ORDINANCE NO. 2876**

9 An ordinance enacting a new section to Chapter 2 Administration of the Code
10 of Ordinances of the City of Slidell which shall be Section 2-36 entitled, "Municipal Police
11 Employees Retirement" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
12

13 WHEREAS, municipal police employees of the City of Slidell, Louisiana have
14 been participating in the Municipal Police Employees Retirement System established by the
15 State of Louisiana under LSA- Revised Statutes 11:2211 through 11:2234 for several years;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell, Louisiana has not officially adopted an
18 ordinance extending to municipal police employees and eligible elected officials of the City
19 of Slidell, Louisiana the provisions of LSA-Revised Statutes 11:2211 through 11:2234 which
20 provide for a retirement system for municipal police employees and eligible elected officials;
21 and

22 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell desires to ratify and confirm the participation of
23 municipal police employees and eligible elected officials in the Municipal Police Employees
24 Retirement System established by the State of Louisiana under LSA Revised Statutes
25 11:2211 through 11:2234.


26 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council in legal
27 session convened that a new section shall be added to Chapter 2 Administration of the
28 Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell which shall be Section 2-36 of the Code of
29 Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Louisiana to be entitled, "Municipal Police Employees
30 Retirement" which is hereby enacted to read as follows:

31 "Section 2-36. Municipal Police Employees Retirement.

- 32 a. The provisions of LSA-Revised Statutes 11:2211 through 11:2234, and any
33 amendments thereto, establishing the Municipal Police Employees
34 Retirement System, shall be applicable to eligible municipal police employees
35 and eligible elected officials of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

7 b. Eligible municipal police employees and eligible elected officials of the City of
8 Slidell, Louisiana may take such actions as may be required by applicable
9 laws and regulations in order to receive benefits under applicable state law."


