9 **ORDINANCE NO. 2884**

11 An ordinance amending Chapter 2 Administration of the Code of Ordinances
12 of the City of Slidell to provide city service discounts to a greater number of senior citizens
13 and handicapped individuals.
14

15 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell provides discounts to senior citizens and certain
16 handicapped individuals having a household income of less than Fifteen Thousand Dollars
17 (\$15,000) per year; and

18 WHEREAS, these discounts apply to garbage collection fees, trash collection
19 fees, water and sewer, and others as may be designated by the Mayor; and

20 WHEREAS, the said Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) threshold is deemed
21 to be too low.

22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
23 hereby amend its Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2 Administration, Article VIII. REDUCTION
24 OF CERTAIN FEES FOR THE ELDERLY, Section 2-121. Qualification for exemption from
25 special fees; definition as follows:

26 Paragraph (a) delete the language "Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000)" and replace
27 with "Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000)".

28 Section 2-122. Eligibility; application.

29 Paragraph (a) delete the language "Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000)" and
30 replace with "Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000)".




