7 **ORDINANCE NO. 2887**

9 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate
10 the adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of
11 the Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
12 Police Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General
13 Government, as well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on
14 outstanding general obligation bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2000.
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16 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City
17 of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an
18 aggregate tax of thirty-six and twenty-five one hundredths (36.25) mills on the dollar
19 upon all property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said
20 City, according to the assessment roll of said City in the calendar year 1999.

21 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is
22 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:

23 A tax of 6.18 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues
24 to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general
25 municipal and local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2000, as
26 shown by the budget for the year 2000, adopted by the City Council of said City. So
27 authorized by Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27 at 6.18 mills.

28 A tax of 3.0 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
29 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2000. So
30 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana,
31 November 8, 1984.

32 A tax of 2.53 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
33 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2000. So
34 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April
35 4, 1981.

36 A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in the
37 City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2000. So authorized by the special taxpayer
38 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.
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6 A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of
7 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2000. So authorized by the special
8 taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.

9 A tax of 2.53 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving
10 public works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2000. So authorized
11 by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.

12 A tax of 5.03 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
13 interest and maturing bonds for the 1994 General Obligation Refunding Bonds of the
14 City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2000, as authorized by a special election held
15 November 8, 1988, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of
16 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 8th day of March, 1994.

17 A tax of 6.98 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
18 interest and maturing bonds for the 1996 General Obligation Bonds for the City of
19 Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2000, as authorized by a special election held
20 November 18, 1995, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of
21 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 12th day of September, 1995.






