8 **ORDINANCE NO. 2894**

10 An ordinance amending Chapter 18 Taxicabs of the Code of Ordinances of  
11 the City of Slidell to permit the use of station wagons and vans for the transporting of  
12 passengers, packages, and parcels.  
13

14 WHEREAS, the definition of taxicabs was established by the City of Slidell on  
15 July 22, 1980, and provided for the carrying of a maximum of six (6) passengers; and

16 WHEREAS, the taxicab industry has expanded to provide other services  
17 including the transportation of packages and parcels and the use of vans which are capable  
18 of carrying more than six (6) people.

19 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does  
20 hereby amend its Code of Ordinances Chapter 18 Taxicabs, Section 18-1. Defined. as  
21 follows:

22 Delete the first paragraph in its entirety and replace with:

23 "A taxicab within the meaning of this chapter is defined to mean any motor  
24 vehicle for hire having a normal seating capacity of less than twelve (12) passengers which  
25 is used for the transportation of passengers over any streets by a route or to a destination  
26 controlled by the passenger, or used for the transportation of packages or parcels to a  
27 destination controlled by the hirer. This definition shall not apply to carriers by motor vehicle  
28 subject to the jurisdiction of the Louisiana Public Service Commission or engaged solely in  
29 interstate commerce."




