8 **ORDINANCE NO. 2906**

11 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
12 Chapter 9 Criminal Code, Section 9-60 Discharging Firearms, to provide proposed
13 guidelines for indoor shooting range.

15 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
16 hereby amend its Code of Ordinances Chapter 9 Criminal Code, Section 9-60 Discharging
17 Firearms by adding the following paragraph:

18 Shooting galleries shall comply with the following requirements:


- 19 1. "Shooting Gallery" - means and includes any place or premises where facilities or
20 devices for target shooting for practice or amusement with any firearm are provided
21 for the use of any person for a fee, pay or compensation of any kind to be paid.
- 22 2. No person shall keep, conduct or operate any shooting gallery or other place where
23 firearms are discharged in the city without first being issued an occupational license
24 by the City Finance Department. Prior to the issuance of said license, approval
25 must be given by the Director of Planning, Permits and the Chief of Police.
- 26 3. Prior to issuance of a building permit for construction of a shooting gallery, plans
27 and specifications signed and stamped by a registered architect or engineer must
28 be submitted to the Permit Department. Approval must also be received from the
29 Louisiana State Fire Marshall.
- 30 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a shooting gallery without first
31 obtaining the written permission of two-thirds of the property owners within a
32 150 foot radius of the location of the proposed gallery. In the case where multiple
33 owners own an adjacent property, one signature shall constitute approval. Any
34 shooting gallery shall be enclosed within a building as to prevent the report of
35 firearms being heard in the street on which it may be located.



7 5. Shooting galleries shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the current
8 publication of the National Rifle Association, or it's successor, entitled "The Range
9 Manual".
