ORDINANCE NO. 2920

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 2 Administration, Sec. 2-10. Central purchasing and leasing; advertising; public bidding, setting forth certain requirements for the purchase of computer hardware, computer software, and related computer equipment.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has implemented a new technology plan for municipal employees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to have the Police Department be a participant of said technology plan; and

WHEREAS, compatibility and consistency in computer and computer related technology would benefit the whole City; and

WHEREAS, individual departments have frequently obtained their own quotes and prices for such computers; and


WHEREAS, when this happens, the Purchasing Department no longer functions as a Purchasing Department, but becomes an ordering department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend its Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2 Administration, Sec. 2-10 Central purchasing and leasing; advertising; public bidding, by adding a new paragraph (g) as follows:

"(g) All purchases or leases of computer and computer related equipment, in excess of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), made by any City Department shall be reviewed by the City Data Processing Manager or City appointed Computer Consultant prior to the City Purchasing Department's solicitation of bids, quotes, or proposals."

Amend 2-10(a) to add: "The Purchasing Department shall be responsible for obtaining all bids, quotes or proposals for the purchase or lease of all property, supplies, materials or services. Individual City Departments shall not solicit such bids, quotes or proposals."


