If you're new to Olde Towne, you won't want to miss out on the fun!

Here's some more information about this year's event:

- During *Arts Evening*, the City of Slidell will host George Dunbar: A Retrospective at the Slidell Cultural Center at City Hall. We anticipate that this exhibit will draw more art lovers to Olde Towne, a benefit to all the participating artists and businesses.
- In the event of inclement weather, *Arts Evening* will be rescheduled for a future date. Any cancellation decisions will be made by Thursday, March 17, so that businesses will have adequate time to make scheduling adjustments for staff, food or catering changes, and that artists and entertainers have enough time to make alternate plans.
- We offer several options for host businesses, including hosting artists and their works. Your business can also opt to participate in the event without hosting an artist. This option makes it easier for location with limited display space.
- This year's *Arts Evening* brochure will be digital. Attendees will be able to view the brochure on their cell phones or print the brochure. Since we no longer have printing costs for the brochure, we will not be collecting an *Arts Evening* fee from each participating business.

With participation in *Arts Evening*, the Host Business will comply with the rules and regulations set forth by the *Arts Evening* Committee, Department of Cultural & Public Affairs and City of Slidell, including, but not limited to the following:

Prior to *Arts Evening* Night:

- 1. The Host Business will contact or be contacted by the Artist(s) no later than Wednesday, March 9, 2022, so that the artists may introduce themselves, discuss display space, special needs and decide on times to set up artwork.
- 2. Host Businesses who represent their own artists must provide artist information to the Slidell Department of Cultural Affairs no later than Monday, March 7, 2022.
- 3. The Host Business will receive an *Arts Evening* poster. The poster should arrive at the end of February. The Committee asks that the poster be prominently displayed in your front door or window.

Arts Evening Night:

- 1. The Host Business will have its business and surrounding area cleaned and well-lit for that night.
- 2. The Host Business will have display space clean and available for the Artist(s) and will give the Artist(s) ample time to set up the display.
- 3. The Host Business will be open for business from 5:00 to 9:00 p.m.
- 4. We are suggesting that businesses refrain from serving heavy refreshments (or limit refreshments to something very light, like cheese trays and desserts) so that *Arts Evening* patrons are encouraged to dine at participating restaurants.
- 5. In the event of inclement weather, *Arts Evening* will be rescheduled for a future date. Any cancellation decisions will be made by Thursday, March 17, so that businesses will have adequate time to make scheduling adjustments for staff, food or catering changes, and that artists and entertainers have enough time to make alternate plans.
