IT IS ORDERED that the structure located at 1000 Canulette Road, Slidell, Louisiana 70458 is hereby condemned.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the owner of the property located at 1000 Canulette Road, Slidell, Louisiana 70458 may, within thirty (30) days of the signing of this order, demolish the property, subject to the contractual and bond requirements of La. R.S. 33:4765.A and permitting.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should the structure located at 1000 Canulette Road, Slidell, Louisiana 70458, **not** be demolished by the property owner within thirty (30) days of the signing of this order, the City of Slidell may demolish same, issue an invoice to the owner, and if not paid, place a lien on the property for the cost of the demolition, and the City may exercise any other rights granted to it under the law.
