8 An ordinance declaring certain boats and boat motors of the Slidell Police
9 Department as surplus and authorizing their donation to the Fort Pike Fire Protection
10 District, pursuant to Louisiana Constitution Article VII, Section 14(E).

11 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell, through the Slidell Police Department, has
12 identified certain boats and boat motors, identified on the attached Exhibit A, as no longer
13 being required for the public functions of the City, and the City desires to declare such
14 items as surplus property; and

17 WHEREAS, the City further desires to donate such items to the Fort Pike Fire
18 Protection District (see La. R.S. 40:1503.1), who has indicated it will accept such donation
19 for use in connection with its public safety functions; and

22 WHEREAS, Louisiana Constitution, Article VII, Section 14(E) allows for the
23 donation of movable surplus property between or among political subdivisions whose
24 functions include public safety.

27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal
28 session convened, as follows:

30 (a) The boats and boat motors identified on attached Exhibit A are declared
31 surplus.

33 (b) The City of Slidell, acting through its Mayor or Chief of Police, is authorized
34 to donate said boats and boat motors to the Fort Pike Fire Protection District
