7 An ordinance for the City of Slidell setting forth and designating the City's  
8 millage rates, as required by Part II of Article VII of the Constitution of Louisiana and other  
9 applicable law, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police Department,  
10 Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, and General Government, as well as  
11 for providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general obligation  
12 bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2023-2024.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of Slidell,  
14 Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate tax of 26.06  
15 mills on the dollar upon all property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana,  
16 situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of said City, in the calendar year  
17 2023.

21 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is  
22 composed of the following authorized tax levies:  
23

24 A tax of 4.88 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues  
25 to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal  
26 and local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2023-2024, as authorized  
27 by Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27.

30 A tax of 2.88 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the  
31 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2023-2024, as  
32 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on  
33 November 19, 2013.

4 A tax of 2.05 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the

10 A tax of 3.85 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in

15 A tax of 4.72 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of  
16 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2023-2024, as authorized by the special  
17 taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on November 19, 2013.

20 A tax of 1.93 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving  
21 public works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2023-2024, as authorized  
22 by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on April 4, 1981.

25 A tax of 5.75 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay  
26 interest and maturing principal on general obligation bonds for the City of Slidell,  
27 Louisiana, for fiscal year 2023-2024, *consisting of* (i) 2.99 mills for the City's 2016 General  
28 Obligation Bonds, as authorized by a special election held April 9, 2016, by City Resolution  
29 R16-04 adopted on January 26, 2016, and by City Ordinance No. 3830 adopted on August  
30 9, 2016; and (ii) 2.76 mills for the City's 2021 General Obligation Refunding Bonds, as  
31 originally authorized by a special election held on October 17, 2009, by City Resolution  
32 R09-23 adopted on July 28, 2009, by City Ordinance No. 3562 adopted on March 23,
