An ordinance changing certain staffing levels within the City of Slidell's Police Department.

WHEREAS, under City Ordinance 4126, the City Council established personnel staffing and position classification levels for each City department for fiscal year 2023-2024; and

WHEREAS, City Council approval is generally required to amend, change, increase, or reallocate any pay grade levels or staffing; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, the City Council desires to authorize the elimination of the two Crime Scene Evidence Tech (Crime Scene Technician) positions within the Police Department in favor of the addition of a Police Officer 3rd class position within the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriations have been made for the Police Department to fund such modified staffing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that, within the Police Department, it does hereby (i) eliminate the two Crime Scene Evidence Tech (Crime Scene Technician) positions; and (ii) add a Police Officer 3rd class position.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
