## **ORDINANCE NO. 4143**

An ordinance amending Chapter 11, Article V, Section 11-704(b) and Chapter 13, Article III, Section 13-54(a) of the City of Slidell's Code of Ordinances to update the penalties for littering under the City's codal provisions on littering.

WHEREAS, Chapter 11 and Chapter 13 of City's Code of Ordinances contain certain criminal misdemeanor sections related to littering that are enforced by authorized City employees and the courts; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update the penalty provisions of those sections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that it does hereby amend Chapter 11, Article V, Section 11-704(b) of the City of Slidell's Code of Ordinances, as reflected in the following redlines:

- (b) (1) Whoever violates the provisions of this Ssection shall, upon first conviction, be fined not less than one hundred dollars nor more than \$250.00 and sentenced to serve four hours of community service in a litter abatement work program as approved by the court.
  - (2) Upon second conviction, an offender shall be fined not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$350.00 \$500.00 and sentenced to serve eight hours of community service in a litter work abatement work program as approved by the court.
  - (3) Upon third or subsequent conviction, an offender shall be fined-not less than \$350.00 nor more than \$500.00 \$1,000.00, be imprisoned for not more than six months, orand sentenced to serve not less than 24 hours of community service in a litter abatement work program as approved by the court, or all or any combination of the aforementioned penalties.

(4) The judge may require an individual convicted of a violation of this section to remove litter from public streets, public rights of way, public parks, public playgrounds or other appropriate locations for any prescribed period of time in lieu of the penalties prescribed in this section.

BE IT FURTHER ORDINANED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that it does hereby amend Chapter 13, Article III, Section 13-54(a) of the City of Slidell's Code of Ordinances, as reflected in the following redlines:

- (a) (1) Whoever violates the provisions of this article shall, upon first conviction, be fined not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$250.00 and sentenced to serve four hours of community service in a litter abatement work program as approved by the court.
  - (2) Upon second conviction, an offender shall be fined not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$350.00 \$500.00 and sentenced to served eight hours of community service in a litter work abatement work program as approved by the court.
  - (3) Upon third or subsequent conviction, an offender shall be fined not less than \$350.00 nor more than \$500.00 \$1,000.00, be imprisoned for not more than six months, orand sentenced to serve not less than 24 hours of community service in a litter abatement work program as approved by the court, or all or any combination of the aforementioned penalties.
  - (4) The judge may require an individual convicted of a violation of this article to remove litter from public streets, public rights-of-way, public parks, public playgrounds or other appropriate locations for any prescribed period of time in lieu of the penalties prescribed in this article.
  - (5) Notwithstanding anything in the Code to the contrary, the penalty provisions set forth in this subsection (a) for violations of this article shall

> control over the penalty provisions of section 1-12 of the Code for such violations.
