- ❖ A Development Permit or proposed site plan must be submitted with a Land Clearing Permit application.
- ❖ An approved Land Clearing Permit will expire six (6) months from the date it is approved.
- ❖ Tree diameter is measured at DBH; see Appendix A, Part 2, Section 2.25.A.5.g.

**Required – Tree Survey & Development Plan**

- On a measured survey of the property, **indicate ALL trees proposed to be removed.** Identify:
- Property boundaries
  - Property identification
  - Location, DBH, and species of trees to be removed
  - Location, DBH, and species of each protected tree or group of trees proposed to remain
  - Existing structures and paving
  - Proposed structures and paving
  - Adjacent street(s)

**Replacement Acknowledgement REQUIRED**

Trees removed with a permit will be required to be replaced on a one-to-one ratio within one growing season, or per approved mitigation plan as submitted to the Planning Department. Replacement trees must meet the minimum plant standards described in Section 2.25.C.4. If approved by the Director of Planning, the planting of replacement trees can be delayed to the beginning of the next planting season to provide the best opportunity for the planting to take root and survive. In no case will the planting of replacement trees be delayed beyond the next planting season. If replacing more than five (5) trees, the developer must provide a performance bond as a guarantee of the tree(s) replacement. The property owner acknowledges this requirement by signature below and will provide photographic evidence of compliance to the Planning Department upon completion of this requirement.
