ORDINANCE NO. 1228

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive a petition from R. C. McIntosh, Sr. and Laura McIntosh, requesting the annexation and zoning to C-4 of the following described property, and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning Commission, in a letter dated

November 20th, 1979, recommended approval of such an annexation and zoning, and

WHEREAS, by publication in the Slidell Daily Times on December 13th, 20th, and 27th, 1979, the Council gave notice of their intention to take action on said petition by calling a Public Hearing on January 8th, 1980, at 6:30 P.M., in the Council Chambers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the following described property be annexed and become part of the City of Slidell, and zoned C-4, (Council District B).

Situated in Section 44, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, described as commencing at the northwest corner of Section 23, Township 9 South, Range 14 East; run thence south 39 degrees, 45 minutes east on northerly line of Section 44, 1,966 feet to an iron stob; thence north 65 degrees, 30 minutes west; 339 feet; thence north 41 degrees, 15 minutes west, 36.7 feet; thence south 18 degrees, 30 minutes west, 16.4 feet to the point of beginning on the west side of Howze Beach Road; thence continue on same course along the west line of Howze Beach Road 367.6 feet; thence west 140 feet to a stob; thence north 636 feet to a stob on the edge of New Orleans/Slidell Highway (State Highway #2); thence south 41 degrees, 15 minutes east, along said highway 385 feet to point of beginning. Containing 2.44 acres, more or less. All as more fully shown on a plan of survey by Joseph Pugh, Parish Surveyor, dated November 20, 1944. Annexed to an act before Felix H.
