Six and twenty-seven hundredth (6.27) mills on the dollar for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenue to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal and local purposes of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1980, as shown by the budget for the year 1980 adopted by the City of Slidell, Louisiana City Council.
