ORDINANCE NO. 1240

An Ordinance to provide revenue for the City of Slidell, Louisiana,  
for the purpose of paying and defraying the general expenses of the City of  
Slidell, Louisiana, for the general and local purposes of the year 1980.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City  
of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that six and twenty-seven  
hundredth (6.27) mills on the dollar is hereby levied on all taxable property  
under the laws of the State of Louisiana which is situated in the corporate  
limits of the City of Slidell and according to the assessment roll of the  
said City for the year 1979, which assessment roll is now on file in the  
office of the Director of Finance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, to-wit:

Six and twenty-seven hundredth (6.27) mills on the dollar for the  
purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenue to pay and defray the  
expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal and local  
purposes of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1980, as shown by  
the budget for the year 1980 adopted by the City of Slidell, Louisiana City  
Council.






