ORDINANCE NO. 1254

WEED AND NOXIOUS GROWTHS ORDINANCE

An Ordinance amending Section 11-50 through 11-53 of the
Slidell Code of Ordinance and Ordinance 341, adopted October
2nd, 1928, to specify trash as well as weeds, clarifying
language, and clarifying charging policies.

The Council of the City of Slidell hereby ordains that Sections
11-50 through 11-53 (Ordinance Number 341) of the Slidell Code of Ordinance,
be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 11-50 amended to read: The growth of weeds, grass and other
underbrush, as well as the placement of trash, debris, refuse, discarded or
noxious matter on any lot, place, area, or sidewalk or sidewalk area in the
City is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and detrimental to the general
health of the City.

SECTION 11-51 amended to read: All owners of land within the City or
the duly authorized agents of said owners, shall cut and remove all the rank
growth of weeds, grass, and other underbursh, discarded or noxious matter on
any lot, place, area, and the sidewalks and sidewalk areas adjacent to their
property.

SECTION 11-52: After the word "forth", add: or to fail to remove
any trash, debris, refuse, discarded or noxious matter....

After the word "agents.", remove the period and add the following:
or after notice has been given the owner or owners by advertisement in the official
journal of the City of Slidell for two (2) consecutive days.

SECTION 11-53: After the word "removing", add: and a \$25.00 service
charge.
