ORDINANCE NO. 1266

SUNDAY LAW EXEMPTION

10 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened,  
11 that all businesses, persons, or firms licensed to and selling, servicing or  
12 dispensing alcoholic beverages at retail within the city limits of Slidell be  
13 and they are hereby exempted from the effect and operation of the provisions of  
14 Louisiana Revised Statutes 51:191 and 51:192 so that any such persons, firms  
15 or businesses licensed to, may sell, serve, or dispense alcoholic beverages  
16 at retail on Sunday.

24 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all businesses, persons or firms who  
25 are licensed to sell or dispense high and low content alcoholic beverages at  
26 retail by the drink shall close their doors to entry at two o' clock Sunday  
27 morning and remain closed until ten o' clock Sunday morning. Patrons who are  
28 present in the establishment at closing time may remain inside the establishment  
29 at the discretion of the operator of said establishment. Any patron leaving  
30 the establishment at or after two o' clock A.M., may not re-enter said  
31 establishment.

40 A notice delineating the provisions of this ordinance shall be  
41 posted in a conspicuous place on a placard of at least twelve (12) by eighteen  
42 (18) inches, in each place of business which is licensed to sell or dispense  
43 high and low content alcoholic beverages by the drink.

48 Any violation of this ordinance by businesses, persons or firms  
49 licensed to sell or dispense high and low content alcoholic beverages at retail  
50 by the drink shall be punishable by a fine of Two Hundred and No/100th (\$200.00)  
51 Dollars or sixty (60) days in jail or both.



58 time, unless repealed or unless the voters decide otherwise in a referendum.
