ORDINANCE NUMBER 1270

CHARTER AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3-04C

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened,  
that the present Section 3-04C of the Slidell City Charter is hereby repealed  
and replaced with a new Section 3-04C to read as follows:


C. If a vacancy in the office of mayor occurs six (6) months or more  
prior to the expiration of the term of office, the council member-at-large  
receiving the greatest number of votes shall serve as mayor until the office is  
filled by the vote of the qualified electors voting in a special election called  
by the council for that purpose, which election shall be held not later than  
sixty (60) days after the vacancy occurred. A vacancy in the office of mayor  
occurring less than six (6) months prior to the expiration of the term of office  
shall be filled by the council member-at-large receiving the greatest number of  
votes and shall serve as mayor for the remainder of the term. The council member  
serving as mayor shall not have a vote on the council or otherwise participate  
in council activities as a member thereof while serving as mayor.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this proposed amendment be submitted for  
ratification to the qualified voters of the City of Slidell.
