ORDINANCE NUMBER 1272

CHARTER AMENDMENT TO SECTION 4-05H


BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened,
that the present Section 4-05H of the Slidell City Charter is hereby repealed
and replaced with a new Section 4-05H to read as follows:

H. A vacancy in the office of police chief occurring six (6) months
or more prior to the expiration of the term shall be filled by the vote of the
qualified electors voting in a special election called by the council for that
purpose, which election shall be held not later than sixty (60) days after the
vacancy occurred. If a vacancy in the office of police chief occurs with less
than six (6) months remaining in the term, no special election shall be held
and the assistant police chief shall assume the office of police chief for the
remainder of the term.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this proposed amendment be submitted for
ratification to the qualified voters of the City of Slidell.


