ORDINANCE NO. 1273

WHEREAS, the residents of Bonfouca Estates and their ancestors in title have paid approximately Fifteen Thousand Nine Hundred and No/100th (\$15,900.00) Dollars of taxes into the City of Slidell's sewer maintenance fund, and

WHEREAS, there has been no sewer system to maintain in Bonfouca Estates, and

WHEREAS, this constitutes the payment of taxes for no service received, and

WHEREAS, the people of Bonfouca Estates have a need and a right to derive some benefit from the aforementioned taxes paid,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that:

Section 1. The City of Slidell shall make available to Bonfouca Estates Fifteen Thousand Nine Hundred and No/100th (\$15,900.00) Dollars to be used toward payment of costs for the installation of a water line throughout Bonfouca Estates.

Section 2. This sum of money shall be made available immediately upon approval by the people of Bonfouca Estates of the installation of a water line throughout their area to be financed by a front-foot assessment which shall be supplemented by Fifteen Thousand Nine Hundred and No/100th (\$15,900.00) Dollars from the City of Slidell.

Section 3. The Fifteen Thousand Nine Hundred and No/100th (\$15,900.00) Dollars shall be funded from any of the following sources:

- (a) Unencumbered funds from the 1979-80 Budget,
- (b) Funds from the 1979-80 Supplemental Budget,
- (c) Any excess or unencumbered funds from the Chamale' Cove contract.
