ORDINANCE NO. 1289

An Ordinance amending Article II - High Content Beverage Control,
Section 3-25, "Location of Business Limited", of the City of
Slidell Code of Ordinances and Ordinance Number 996.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened,
that Article II - High Content Beverage Control, Section 3-25 of the Slidell
Code of Ordinances, and Ordinance Number 996, adopted January 13th, 1976, is
amended as follows:

Delete the second sentence in its entirety and replace with the
following:

For bona fide restaurants as defined in Section 3-18 (c) of the
Slidell Code of Ordinances applying for a permit for light wines
only as defined in Section 3-18(b) of the Slidell Code of Ordinances,
this distance shall be measured as a person walks, using the sidewalk,
from the nearest point of the property line of the church or
synagogue, library, playground, or school, to the front door of
the building or structure to be licensed. For all other alcoholic
beverage outlets, the measurement of this distance shall be from the
nearest point of the property line of a church, synagogue, school,
library or playground, to the nearest point of the property line of
the premises to be licensed.




