ORDINANCE NO. 1303

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, annexing and zoning a parcel of land.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council, the governing body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Mr. James B. Harris requesting the annexation and zoning to A-7 Multi-Family Urban of a parcel of land, and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning Commission, in a letter dated September 18th, 1980, recommended approval of said annexation and zoning, and by publication in the Slidell Daily Times on September 26th, October 3rd, and October 10th, 1980, the Council gave notice of their intention to take action on said petition by calling a public hearing on October 14th, 1980, at 6:30 P.M., in the Council Chambers,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the following described property be annexed into the City of Slidell, Council District E, and zoned A-7 Multi-Family Urban:

A certain parcel of land located in Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commence at a point described as being north 1810.0 feet and east 922.0 feet from the Section corner common to Sections 10, 11, 14, and 15, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, and measure south 50.0 feet to the point of beginning; thence east 135.0 feet, thence south 150.0 feet, thence west 135.0 feet, thence north 150.00 feet to the point of beginning, as per survey by Ned R. Wilson, dated March 7th, 1980.

The property is generally located south of Fremaux Avenue and west and north of Possum Hollow Road.
