ORDINANCE NO. 1319

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened,
that all motorized vehicles are hereby banned from utilizing the jogger's path
at Possum Hollow Park.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City of Slidell shall post signs to
this effect.

BE IT ALSO ORDAINED that bicycle riders shall yield to joggers in
said park and that the City of Slidell shall erect signs to this effect.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that all violations of this ordinance shall be
punishable by a fine of One Hundred and No/100ths (\$100.00) Dollars or
imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both.
