BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is SECTION 2. levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the City Hall Improvement and Jail and Courthouse Bonds for the City of Slidell for the year 1981, as duly authorized by special taxpayers election held on August 4, 1962 and by Resoultion 662 of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 6th day of August, 1962.
