ORDINANCE NO. 1360

An ordinance calling for an election on April 4th, 1981,  
to levy a two and one-half (2.5) Mill tax on all property  
in Slidell, Louisiana.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened,  
that an election shall be held on April 4th, 1981, in the City of Slidell, at  
which election there shall be submitted to all registered voters qualified and  
entitled to vote at said election under the Constitution and laws of the State  
of Louisiana, and the Constitution of the United States, the following propo-  
sition, to wit:

PROPOSITION

Proposition to levy a two and one-half (2.5) Mill tax on  
all the property subject to taxation in the City of Slidell,  
Louisiana, for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and  
improving public works within the City of Slidell, includ-  
ing the acquisition of the necessary equipment therefor.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective  
immediately upon approval by the Mayor.




