ORDINANCE NO. 1366

An ordinance raising the rate of water to users not located within the corporate limits of the City of Slidell and adding Section 20-10 to the Slidell Code of Ordinances.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that Section 20-10 is added to the Slidell Code of Ordinances to read as follows:

The following monthly rate for the service of water to residences and businesses not in the city limits shall be charged:

(1) Where no meters are installed the charge for residences shall be \$15.00.

(2) Where meters are installed the charge for residences shall be a minimum charge of \$15.00 and \$1.00 per thousand gallons in excess of 15,000.

(3) Where no meters are installed the charge for businesses shall be \$20.00.

(4) Where meters are installed the charge for businesses shall be a minimum of \$20.00 plus \$1.25 per thousand gallons in excess of 16,000.

Houses, businesses or other users connected to the city water system but not paying for city water may be billed retroactively at these rates for three (3) years.






