EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 1369

An emergency ordinance authorizing the repair of a drainage
pump at Bayou Potassat.

WHEREAS, one of the two drainage pumps at Bayou Potassat has broken
down, and

WHEREAS, the pumps are needed to handle heavy rainfall which can
especially be expected to occur during the spring months, and

WHEREAS, without the pump there is a threat to the property and
safety of the public,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal
session convened, that a state of public emergency affecting life, health,
property, and public safety is hereby declared and that the Mayor of the City
of Slidell is authorized to take emergency steps to have repaired the inoperable
drainage pump at Bayou Potassat and to sign a contract with Lo-Lift Pump Company
of Welch, Louisiana, for \$6,700.00 to \$6,900.00 for repair of the pump.
