5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3052**

7 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell by
8 adding a new Section 18-4 to provide for irrevocable election to participate in the
9 provisions of Louisiana Revised Statute 11:2218(J) relative to conversion of unused
10 sick and annual leave to retirement credit.

11
12 WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statute 11:2218(J) is a statutory provision
13 applicable to the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System relative to the
14 conversion of unused sick and annual leave to retirement credit; and

15
16 WHEREAS, the conversion of such unused leave is allowed for any
17 member of the System whose employing municipality **irrevocably** elects such
18 coverage; and

19
20 WHEREAS, once an employing municipality elects to use the conversion
21 option, it may not thereafter change that decision; and

22
23 WHEREAS, the actuarial cost of the conversion of unused sick and
24 annual leave to retirement credit must be borne solely by and paid to the System by
25 the member's employing municipality within thirty (30) days of the date that the
26 member retires.

28 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it
29 does hereby amend its Code of Ordinances by adding a new Section 18-4 as follows:


4 **"Sec. 18-4. Conversion Of Unused Sick And Annual Leave To Retirement**
5 **Credit.**


