## **ORDINANCE NO. 3083**

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 21 Personnel, Sec. 21-22. Employee catastrophic sick leave pool.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council established an Employee catastrophic sick leave pool on March 10, 1998, by Ordinance No. 2797; and

WHEREAS, administration wishes to amend the ordinance to make employee eliqibility requirements less stringent;

WHEREAS, these changes are retroactive to June 1, 2002.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 21 Personnel as follows:

## Sec. 21-22. Employee catastrophic sick leave pool.

In paragraph (1) delete "15 days" and replace with "16 hours".

In paragraph (1) delete the phrase "one year, prior to the diagnosis of a catastrophic illness" and replace with "six months".

In the first sentence of paragraph (2) delete "15 consecutive days of sick leave or vacation leave" and replace with "10 consecutive days of sick leave, vacation leave, or leave without pay".

Delete paragraph "(4)" in its entirety.

Change paragraph "(5)" to paragraph "(4)".

Add a new paragraph "(5)" to read as follows:

(5) Transfer of annual leave or sick leave from one employee to another is prohibited.
