8 An ordinance amending Chapter 19 to provide for rules for usage of City parks.

9  
10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that:

11 (1) Sec.19-8. be amended as follows:

12 (A) The heading be amended to read: "Sec. 19-8. Rules And  
13 Regulations For John Slidell Park Gymnasium And Recreation Center And Fritchie Park  
14 Gymnasium.";

15 (B) In subsections (1), (2), (3), (4), (6) and (8) add the term "or Fritchie  
16 Park Gymnasium" after the word "Center" wherever that word appears;

17 (C) In subsections (5), (7) and (9) add the term "and Fritchie Park  
18 Gymnasium" after the word "Center" wherever that word appears.

19  
20  
21 (2) Add a new section 19-10 to read as follows:

22 "Sec. 19-10. Rules And Regulations For Heritage Park Use.

23 (a) No animals allowed, except service animals or those in  
24 permitted public events.

25 (b) No glass containers allowed

26 (c) No lewd or lascivious behavior allowed.

27 (d) No bicycles or scooters allowed in restricted areas.

- 4 (e) No skateboards allowed.
- 5 (f) No commercial fishing or crabbing activities allowed.
- 6
- 7 (g) Park hours shall be 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Sunday through  
8 Thursday and 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday.
- 9
- 10 (h) The rules and regulations for rental of the Gazebo and  
11 Scogin Station shall be the same as contained in Sec. 10-22  
12 through 10-28 and 10-31, as applicable.
- 13 (i) Anyone renting the Gazebo or Scogin Station shall be  
14 responsible for supplying, setting up and taking down their  
15 own tables and chairs subject to the supervision of the Parks  
16 and Recreation Department.
- 17 (j) Motor vehicles must yield the right of way to pedestrians.
- 18 (k) Any person convicted of damaging or vandalizing any  
19 property at Heritage Park shall be subject to the penalty  
20 provisions of Sec. 1-12. The Court may in its discretion  
21 order community service in lieu of imprisonment.
- 22 (l) No overnight sleeping allowed.
- 23
- 24 (m) No camping allowed.
- 25
- 26 (n) No open fires allowed.
- 27 (o) No vehicle parking allowed on the grass. Vehicle parking  
28 shall be allowed only in designated areas.”
