8 **ORDINANCE NO. 3091**

9 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell by
10 adding a new section, Sec. 10-33, to establish a fee schedule for usage of structures
11 located in Heritage Park.

12 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend its
13 Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell by adding a new section, Sec. 10-33, as
14 follows:

17 **Sec. 10-33. Fee Schedule for Heritage Park Structures.**

19 **A.** The fee schedule for structures located in Heritage Park which are available
20 for rent shall be as follows:

<u>Facility</u>	<u>Rental</u>
Gazebo and Scoggin Station Group 2	\$150.00 for four hours \$250.00 for eight hours \$ 25.00 for each extra hour
Group 3	\$200.00 for four hours \$300.00 for eight hours \$ 25.00 for each extra hour
Group 4	\$300.00 for four hours \$500.00 for eight hours \$ 50.00 for each extra hour
Gazebo Only Group 2	\$100.00 for four hours \$150.00 for eight hours \$ 15.00 for each extra hour

22 B. For purposes of this Section:

- 23 1. Group 1: Public agency or City sponsored.
- 24 2. Group 2: Non-profit corporations as defined by R.S. 12:201, et seq.,
25 and having three-fourths of its membership residing in St. Tammany
26 Parish, schools located within St. Tammany Parish or such school
27 sponsored organizations, and private individuals residing in St.
28 Tammany Parish.

- 4 3. Group 3: Non-profit corporations as defined by R.S. 12:201, et seq.,
5 having less than three-fourths of its membership residing in St.
6 Tammany Parish, schools located outside St. Tammany Parish and
7 such school sponsored organizations, and private individuals residing
8 outside St. Tammany Parish.
9
10 4. Group 4: Profit making corporations or companies.
11
12 5. Public agencies are agencies of a federal, state, parish or municipal
13 government, or a state political subdivision.
14
15 6. Public agencies using facilities for activities not open to the general
16 public or for profit making activities shall be subject to Group 2 fee
17 charges.

22 C. The provisions of Sec. 10-26 relating to the use of alcohol shall be
23 applicable to persons renting the Gazebo or Scoggin Station.
