6 **ORDINANCE NO. 3098**

8 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
9 Chapter 23 Solid Waste, to make changes to the City's recycling program.

10 WHEREAS, an evaluation of the recycling program indicates that
11 participation in the program has decreased over the years; and
12

13 WHEREAS, there is no market for recycled glass and Waste
14 Management has been paying Vista Fibers to take co-mingled items (plastic and
15 aluminum) because they cannot be resold at a profit; and

18 WHEREAS, the recycling of newspapers is still viable; and
19

20 WHEREAS, there is support for the "green" recycling aspect, and yard
21 waste has been noted to take up the most landfill space; and
22

23 WHEREAS, residents would no longer have to bundle sticks and
24 branches; and
25

26 WHEREAS, limbs and other yard waste would be picked up on a weekly
27 basis.

5 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it
6 does hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 23 Solid
7 Waste as follows:

10 **Sec. 23-6. Recycling collection fees.**

11 In paragraph (a) delete "\$2.52" and replace with "2.26", and delete the
12 "period" after the word "units" and add "for bi-weekly newspaper recycling."
