Sec. 2-158. Notification of mayor or police chief's temporary absence.

Delete the following sentence from the first paragraph, "The notification shall identify the absence as either personal or business related."

Delete the following section in its entirety:

"Sec. 2-165. Appointment of assistant during absence to be at police chief's discretion."
